) First Supplemental Application No. 27959

ORDER

By Decision No. 39742 dated December 16, 1946, Pacific Electric Railway Company was authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Lemon Drive and Imperial Highway in the County of Orange. The authority contained therein was for the period of one year. On December 4, 1947, applicant filed its first supplemental application for an extension of an additional year in which to complete the construction.

On December 23, 1947, Pacific Electric advised that the industry to be served had asked that construction be indefinitely deferred. Applicant therefore requests dismissal of its first supplemental application and vacation of the authority contained in Decision 39742. By the terms of that decision, the authority contained therein has already lapsed and is of no further force or effect.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first supplemental application is dismissed without prejudice.
