O P I N I O N

Applicant seeks authority to reroute its Dominguez-Seal Beach Route in the vicinity of Lincoln Village and Dominguez. It is proposed to operate between the intersection of Carson Street & Harbor View Avenue and the intersection of 223d Street & Santa Fe Avenue, via Carson Street, Bataan Avenue, 218th Street, McHelen Avenue, and 223rd Street instead of Carson Street and Santa Fe Avenue.

In support of the proposed change applicant states that, because of recent residential developments easterly of McHelen Street, many more persons will be conveniently served. Although the change in route will inconvenience a few people living near the present route, these people will not be required to walk more than a quarter to a third of a mile to the proposed service. The rerouting has been considered and approved by the Bureau of Franchises and Public Utilities of the City of Long Beach and by the Dominguez Area Chamber of Commerce. The latter organization states that "the proposed bus route changes serving Lincoln Village and Dominguez would be to the benefit of a far greater number of our citizens,\* \*".

No change in fares or service frequency will result from the proposed rerouting. No other operators are affected.

It appearing that applicant's proposal is necessary for an improved public service, we find that public convenience and necessity require that this application be granted. No public hearing is necessary.

O R D E R

Application therefor having been filed and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the description of the Dominguez-Seal Beach Route appearing in paragraph (2), subparagraph (c) of the Order in Decision No. 39873, be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

Dominguez-Seal Beach Route

Beginning at the intersection of Harbor View Avenue and Harrison Street, thence along Harrison Street, Prospect Avenue, Dominguez Street, Harbor View Avenue, Carson Street, Bataan Avenue, 218th Street, McHelen Avenue, 223rd Street, Santa Fe Avenue, Anaheim Street, Pico Avenue, Broadway, Park Avenue, 2nd Street, Granada Avenue, Ocean Boulevard, Main Street in Seal Beach, Electric Avenue, Bay Boulevard, Westminster Boulevard to main administration gate of the United States Naval Ordnance Depot.

Also, beginning at the intersection of Santa Fe Avenue and Hill Street in the City of Long Beach, thence along Hill Street, Monitor Avenue, Willard Street to its intersection with Santa Fe Avenue.

Also, beginning at the intersection of 2nd Street and Granada Avenue in the City of Long Beach, thence along 2nd Street, The Toledo, Venetia Drive to its intersection with 2nd Street.

(2) That in all other respects Decision No. 39873, as heretofore amended or supplemented, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
