In the matter of the application of the County of Orange for an order authorizing the widening of Crossing No. 2-197.5 over the right of way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway at Los Indios Street at San Juan Capistrano, Orange County, California, and the installation at said crossing of flashing light signals.

O R D E R

The County of Orange is authorized to widen Los Indios Street across tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company (Crossing No. 2-197.4) in the community of San Juan Capistrano, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-two (32) feet and grades of approach not greater than 2%. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals, G.O. No. 75-B.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
