FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 40830 of October 21, 1947, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to substitute a motor truck for motorcycle equipment for operations between his San Francisco and Oakland terminals. By Decision No. 41163, entered today in Application No. 28456, general substitution of trucks for motorcycles in applicant's transbay service is authorized, but may not be accomplished earlier than February 26, 1948. The terminal-to-terminal equipment substitution may not be continued beyond January 31, 1948, under the provisions of Decision No. 40830. In the circumstances, this temporary authority will be extended to February 26, 1948.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that "January 31, 1948" appearing in the order in Decision No. 40830, of October 21, 1947, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby changed to "February 26, 1948," and that in all other respects said Decision No. 40830 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective January 31, 1948.
