BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of the People of the State of California on relation of the Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at grade of the State highway, Route 19, and the tracks of a spur of the Southern Pacific Railroad in the City of Ontario, County of San Bernardino, California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 19 at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Ontario, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-521.24-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Highway crossing shall consist of two divided roadways, the widths of which shall not be less than twenty-five (25) feet, and grades of approach not greater than 1%. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Frotection shall be by one Standard No. 8 flashing light signal for each roadway, G. O. 75-B. No train, motor, engine or car shall enter upon said crossing at a speed greater than six (6) miles per hour. After having entered the crossing it shall be cleared as quickly as practicable.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time

the post

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
