O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to reconstruct the crossing at separated grades of 12th Street in the City of Sacramento under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, at the location shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
