O P I N I O N

California Water & Telephone Company, asks permission to sell to the City of Pasadena for \$7,500., subject to the provisions of the agreement of sale filed as Exhibit 1, the following described property:

"All of said distribution system lying within that portion of the City of Pasadena known as 'Greenwood Annex', annexed under Ordinance No. 3902, consisting of the following items, more or less:

779-feet of 4-inch Cast Iron pipe in Parkwood Avenue
774-feet of 4-inch Cast Iron pipe in Greenwood Avenue
345-feet of 6-inch Cast Iron pipe in Greenwood Avenue
652-feet of 4-inch Steel pipe in San Pasqual Street
50 Water service laterals
46 Water meters"

and

"That portion of said water distribution system located in and under San Pasqual Street between the westerly boundary of said 'Greenwood Annex' and Allen Avenue, and in and

under Allen Avenue between San Pasqual Street and the southerly boundary of the City of Pasadena consisting of the following items, more or less:

163-feet of 4-inch steel pipe in San Pasqual Street
330-feet of 4-inch steel pipe in Allen Avenue
5 Water service laterals and meters"

Applicants report that at an election held on June 6, 1946, the residents of the area known as Greenwood Annex voted that the area be annexed to the City of Pasadena, that on or about June 18, 1946, Ordinance No. 3902 of the City of Pasadena was adopted, which Ordinance approved the annexation of Greenwood Annex to the City of Pasadena, and that said Ordinance No. 3902 become effective June 21, 1946. Applicants further report that the City of Pasadena desires to serve water in said area under its general policy of serving water to all of its inhabitants and to all of the property located within its boundaries, and that the company is willing to withdraw its service in said Greenwood Annex area.

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.

ORDER

The Commission has considered applicants' request and believes that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:

1.. California Water & Telephone Company may sell, after the effective date hereof, and on or before May 1, 1948, the properties referred to above, such sale to be upon the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement on file in this

application as Exhibit 1.

2. Within thirty (30) days after the sale of said properties, California Water & Telephone Company shall file with the Commission a statement showing the date on which said properties were transferred and that it has returned to consumers whose service was transferred to the City of Pasadena any deposits made by them to guarantee the payment of their water bills.

3. The authority herein granted is effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
