SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that footnote number (2) appearing on page 2 of the order contained in Decision No. 40775, rendered on September 30, 1947, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(2) Points from and to which rates apply are as follows: Bakersfield, Burbank, Fresno, Gilroy, Glendale, Kadota, Lodi, Long Beach, Los Angeles, Martinez, Merced, Modesto, Mountain View, Oakland, Pasadena, Pico, Pittsburg, Richmond, Sacramento, San Francisco, San Jose, San Pedro, Santa Clara, Santa Monica, Stockton, Sunnyvale, Torrance and Wilmington - within the limits of San Francisco area and Los Angeles area, as described in Exhibit "C" of the application, over and along any and all public roads, streets and highways available for operation."

In all other respects said Decision No. 40775 shall remain in full force and effect.
