FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that that part of subparagraph (a) of paragraph (3) of the Order of Decision No. 41137 in Application No. 28870 reading as follows:

"(a) As a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers, baggage and packages of express weighing 100 pounds each or less on passenger carrying vehicles only, between Scotia and Trinidad and intermediate points via Eureka and Arcata with diversion to Crannell from Crannell Junction subject to the following provision..."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) As a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers, baggage and packages of express weighing 100 pounds each or less on passenger carrying vehicles only, between Scotia and Trinidad and intermediate points via Eureka and Arcata, serving Redwood Acres Fair Ground by diversion from Eureka upon demand of 6 or more passengers, and with diversion to Crannell from Crannell Junction subject to the following provision...."

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
