ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to remove one Standard No. 3 wigwag at the southwest corner of Culver and Venice Boulevards, Crossing No. 6F-9.23, from the location shown on the application; and to that extent is authorized to deviate from the provisions of Paragraph (c), Section VI of General Order No. 75-8. Prior to the removal of this signal, applicant shall arrange with the City of Culver City for the installation of adequate illumination to display the presence of rail equipment in the intersection when viewed from the southwest side of the crossing. Applicant shall furnish this Commission a certified copy of such agreement at least twenty days in advance of the removal of the wigwag herein provided for.

Within thirty days after removal pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
