ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 29th Avenue, southeasterly of East 12th Street in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-9.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 2 per cent. Protection shall be by existing 2 Standard No. 3 wig-wags and one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
