ORDER AMENDING DECISION No. 41241 AND EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

Decision No. 41241, issued February 24, 1948, and effective March 15, 1948, found that applicant was a public utility water company, rather than a mutual water company, issued to applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity, and authorized applicant to issue certain stock in exchange for outstanding stock.

Andrew T. Jenkins, a protestant in the above proceeding, on March 4, 1948 filed an application for extension of the effective date of said decision. Petitioner alleges that he desires to petition for a rehearing, that counsel who has heretofore represented petitioner cannot continue in the case, that petitioner has consulted new counsel, and that the latter requires time to become familiar with the matter and prepare a petition for rehearing. Petitioner requests that the effective date be extended to April 15, 1948.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That that part of ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 41241 which directs Cabazon Water Company to file rates "within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order" is hereby amended to provide that such rates shall be filed "within thirty days after the effective date of this order."
