BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of the County of Riverside, a body politic and corporate of the State of California, for an order authorizing the abandonment and closing of a crossing of a public highway over the right of way of the Southern Pacific Railroad.

Application No. 29059

ORDER

The County of Riverside is authorized to abandon and close grade crossing No. B-558.7 across Southern Pacific Company's track at the location more particularly described in the application, subject to the following conditions:

1. Within sixty days from the effective date of this order, applicant shall file with this Commission a certified copy of an ordinance or resolution to legally abandon and close the existing grade crossing.
2. All pavement in the crossing area shall be removed at applicant's expense.
3. Applicant shall cause barricades to be erected which will prevent public travel across the former grade crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. The authorization contained herein shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
