**ORIGINAL**O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Richards Boulevard at two points and across 10th Street in an unincorporated portion of Sacramento County, near Sacramento, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

<u>Location</u>	<u>No tracks</u>	<u>Crossing No.</u>
Richards Boulevard between 7th and 10th Streets	3	A-90.81-C
10th Street	1	A-90.86-C
Richards Boulevard between 10th and 11th Streets	2	A-91.03-C
Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), at each crossing.		

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
