SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 30790 (%1 C.R.C. 239) required the maintenance of parity of fares and interchangeability of tickets between applicant and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. Prior orders in this proceeding have suspended these requirements until May 1, 1948. Applicant seeks a further suspension until December 31, 1948, so that it will not be necessary to raise its fares to the higher rail level.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that conditions Nos. 2 and 7 of Decision No. 30790 of April 18, 1938, in Applications Nos. 20170, 20171, 20172 and 20173 be and they are hereby further suspended

until December 31, 1948; and that appropriate amendments of applicant's tariffs may be filed on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
