O R D E R

Santa Maria Valley Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across public roads near Santa Maria, Santa Barbara County, as follows:

| <u>Road</u> | <u>Crossing No.</u> | <u>Protection</u> |
|--|---------------------|---------------------|
| A portion of County Road adjacent to main line | 38B-8.0-C | 2 Std. No. 1 signs. |
| A portion of Rosemary Road | 38B-8.1-C | 1 Std. No. 1 sign. |
| Foxen Canyon Road (State Highway) | 38B-8.6-C | 2 Std. No. 1 signs. |
| A portion of Rosemary Road | 38B-9.0-C | 1 Std. No. 1 sign. |

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the roads now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) as shown above.

Prior to beginning construction of said crossings applicant shall file with the Commission certified copies of permits from the County of Santa Barbara and the State of California, Department of Public Works, for construction of the crossings with the roads under their respective jurisdiction. Unless such permits are filed within 90 days from the effective date of this order, the authority herein granted shall thereupon lapse.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions

are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
