In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to abandon its Class "D" station of Dredge, in the County of Butte, State of California, to eliminate the station reference of Dredge from Timetable and other records and to cancel all tariffs to and from said Dredge Station.

ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Dredge for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Dredge, County of Butte; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
