## ORDER

San Joaquin County is authorized to construct Marine Avenue at grade across the North Channel Spur of The Western Pacific Railroad Company near Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-98.8-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost cutside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
