O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct a crossing of State Highway Route 11 at separated grades over the track of the Placerville Branch of Southern Pacific Company, near White Rock, Sacramento County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AH-116.5-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G. O. 26-D.

Upon completion the existing crossing at grade of said highway with the railroad (Crossing No. AH-116.4) shall be abandoned and effectively closed to public use.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
