In the matter of the application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, for an in lieu certificate of public convenience and necessity.

24th Supplemental Application No. 26636

To modify route of Los Angeles-Santa Ana via Downey Motor Coach Line in vicinity of Downey.

ORDER

In this proceeding Pacific Electric Railway Company seeks authority to make a minor modification in the route of its Los Angeles-Santa Ana via Downey Motor Coach Line in the vicinity of Downey. As justification for this request, applicant states that its inbound coaches are subject to delay and hazard when attempting to enter Anaheim-Telegraph Road from Paramount Boulevard. The proposed route will permit coaches to enter Anaheim-Telegraph Road at Lakewood Boulevard where protection is provided by traffic signals. The rerouting will also provide direct service to a shopping district in the vicinity of Anaheim-Telegraph Road and Lakewood Boulevard, as well as to a school on Lexington and Callatin Road. Territory along the portion of route to be abandoned is very lightly settled and a check of traffic indicates that approximately eight passengers per day will be inconvenienced by the change. No change in fares or service is involved. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Route 1-C of Appendix A in Decision No. 38827, dated April 9, 1946, be amended to read as follows:

Route 1-C

From Anaheim-Telegraph Road and Lakewood Boulevard, via Lakewood Boulevard, Lexington and Callatin Road, Florence Avenue, Downey Avenue (Downey), and Firestone Boulevard to San Antonio Drive (Norwalk).

Fares applying to or from Paramount and Foster Bridge Boulevard will apply between Lakewood Boulevard and Lexington and Gallatin Road and points north or west thereof, or between Lakewood Boulevard and Anaheim-Telegraph Road and points south thereof.

Applicant shall afford the public five days' notice in advance of the change by placing notices in all equipment used in this service.

In all other respects Decision No. 38827, as subsequently amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
