O R D E R

The City of San Diego is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing as an extension of "K" Street across the La Mesa Branch of the San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the city of San Diego at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36D-3.5-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense; also maintenance cost outside of lines 2 feet outside of rails. San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not more than 10 feet and grades of approach as shown in Exhibit A attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two special pedestrian crossing warning signs of a type to be approved by the Commission's engineers.

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall become effective 20 days from date hereof.
