In the Matter of the Application of QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY for authority to abandon its non-agency stations of Greenhorn, Pioneer and Rockwell, in the County of Plumas, State of California, to eliminate such station references from official records and to cancel all tariffs to and from said stations.

O R D E R

The verified application of Quincy Railroad Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's stations of Greenhorn, Pioneer and Rockwell for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Quincy Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Greenhorn, Pioneer and Rockwell, County of Plumas; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
