In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a railroad industrial spur track across Sixth Street and along "R" Street, in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across 6th Street and a portion of "R" Street in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. AH-90.05. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
