OPINION AND ORDER

Thomas B. Mezger and Elmer J. Conway, co-partners, conduct public utility warehouse operations at Robbins, and Subaco Station, points situated in Sutter County. These operations are conducted on property leased from Philip R. Collins. Authority is here sought to transfer the warehouse operations to Elmer J. Conway and George T. Story, co-partners, and for Philip R. Collins to lease the property to them. In justification it is said that Thomas B. Mezger desires to withdraw from the business due to ill health. No change in rates or services to the public have been proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Thomas B. Mezger and Elmer J. Conway, co-partners, may, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, transfer to Elmer J. Conway and George T. Story, co-partners, the warehouse business involved in this proceeding; that Thomas B. Mezger and Elmer J. Conway, co-partners, and Elmer J. Conway and George T. Story, co-partners, shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission in so far as they name rates, rules and regulations governing the warehouse operations

here involved to show that the former have withdrawn or cancelled, and that the latter have adopted or established as their own such rates, rules and regulations; that tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61; and, that Elmer J. Conway and George T. Story, co-partners, are authorized to enter into a lease with Philip R. Collins in a form substantially the same as that attached to the application.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
