## Decision No. 41472

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, for an in lieu certificate of public convenience and necessity.

24th Supplemental Application No. 26636

To modify route of Los Angeles-Santa Ana via Downey Motor Coach Line in vicinity of Downey.

## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 41435 dated April 6, 1948, in the abovenumbered proceeding, Pacific Electric Railway Company was authorized to
modify the route of its Los Angeles-Santa Ana via Downey Motor Coach
Line. The fares established therein were those which prevailed prior
to the issuance of Decision No. 41152 dated January 19, 1948, in
Second Supplemental Application No. 27466 and, if established, would
create a different fare between common points than that which is in
existence on applicant's Newport Beach-Balboa Motor Coach Line. It
appears that this differential should be eliminated, and good cause
appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that that portion of Decision No. 41435 which reads:

"Fares applying to or from Paramount and Foster Bridge Boulevard will apply between Lakewood Boulevard and Lexington and Callatin Road and points north or west thereof, or between Lakewood Boulevard and Anaheim-Telegraph Road and points south thereof."

is hereby revoked and the following language is substituted:

Fares applying on Los Angeles-Santa Ana via Downey Line to or from Paramount Boulevard and Foster Bridge Boulevard shall apply to or from Anaheim-Telegraph Road and Lakewood Boulevard.

In all other respects Decision No. 41435 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days from the date hereof.
