OPINION AND ORDER

Walter Gillis was authorized by Decision No. 39453 in Application No. 27691 to acquire an operative right for the transportation of passengers and property between Etna and Gazelle and intermediate points via Callahan.

In this proceeding applicant Gillis requests authority to discontinue and abandon the transportation of passengers between those points asserting as justification therefor that an insufficient number of passengers use the service to justify its continuance and that he has been unable to obtain the necessary public liability insurance to cover such transportation. Applicant proposes to continue highway common carrier operations between those points.

After full consideration of applicant's request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require the passenger stage operation of applicant Gillis between Etna and Gazelle and intermediate points, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- (1) That Walter Gillis is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon service as a passenger stage corporation for the

transportation of passengers between Etna and Gazelle and intermediate points via Callahan and the operative right therefor heretofore acquired by applicant Gillis pursuant to the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 39453 in Application No. 27691 and created by Decision No. 37459 in Application No. 26419 is hereby revoked and annulled.

(2) That within 30 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public applicant shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 by filing in triplicate appropriate supplements to his effective tariffs reflecting the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
