FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission, by Decision No. 39770, as amended, authorized the Los Gatos Telephone Company to furnish service in the Burrell area on or before April 30, 1948.

The Applicant now seeks a further extension of time to July 30, 1948, for the reason that circumstances beyond its control have delayed the delivery and installation of the necessary equipment, and requests permission to make effective in the Burrell area certain rates and conditions of service authorized for the Los Gatos exchange by Decision No. 40459, dated June 28, 1947. The proposed rates are set forth in Exhibit A of the second supplemental application and vary in the following respects from the rates shown in Exhibit F of the original application, which were authorized for the Burrell area by Decision No. 39770 on December 23, 1946:

Exhibit A also provides for the use of airline mileage instead of circuit mileage in the calculation of mileage charges and adds rates for service in the Burrell area with telephones which have keys providing holding and intercommunicating features. These rates are identical with the rates for such service currently applicable in the Los Gatos exchange, except that the rates for business and residence trunks serving telephones equipped with keys are the rates for business and residence individual line service in the Burrell area plus fifty cents. The proposed changes will result in no increases to subscribers, inasmuch as these are new services which have not previously been offered or furnished.

The Applicant requests that the designations Zone 1 and Zone 2 be eliminated, due to the uniformity of rates provided in Exhibit A, and the use of the designation Special Base Rate Area instead of Special Rate Area for the area surrounding Burrell in which no mileage charges are applicable.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Los Gatos Telephone Company may have until July 30, 1948 to begin furnishing service in the Burrell area.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the second paragraph of the order in Decision No. 39770, dated December 23, 1946, be and the same is hereby amended to read:

2. The Los Gatos Telephone Company is authorized to file in accordance with General Order No. 96, and to make effective in the Burrell area coincident with the establishment of service and on not less than ten (10) days' notice the exchange area map and the rates and charges as set forth in Exhibit A attached to the second supplemental application and modified in accordance with the request of applicant at the hearing as discussed in the opinion of Decision No. 39770.
