In the Matter of the Application of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to construct a passing track across Gratton Road at Denair, County of Stanislaus, State of California.

<u>ORDER</u>

The Atchison, Topeka and Senta Fe Reilway Company is authorized to construct a passing track at grade across Gratton Road near Densir, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-1079.2. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the read now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-8).

No train, engine or cars shall be allowed to stand on said passing track within 200 feet from the crossing unless traffic on the highway is protected against main line train movements by a competent employee of applicant acting as a flagman.

Within thirty days after completion pursuent to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
