The Deportment of Public Torks of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 1-E at grade across two tracks of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-55.0-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on plan attached to the Application (Exhibit A). Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G.O. No. 75-B).
