

Decision No. 41586

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of an "On-Ramp" connection at grade to the State highway, Route 69, (Eastshore Freeway), over the drill track of the Port of Oakland, in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, California

O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct an "on ramp" connection to State Highway, Route 69, at grade across a drill track of the Port of Oakland at present operated by Southern Pacific Company near 7th Avenue in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-7.9-C. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B). The cost of construction and maintenance shall be borne in accordance with agreement between the parties. Evidence of such agreement shall be filed with the Commission prior to construction. Should the parties fail to agree the Commission will apportion the cost by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
