## TENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

This proceeding involves transportation of lumber and other forest products for the Owens-Parks Lumber Company from Vernon to points within a thirty mile radius of that city. Applicants have been authorized to deviate from the minimum rates established for this transportation. This authority is scheduled to expire June 26, 1948. A one-year extension is sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that the nature of the service required by the shipper is such that high load factors for applicants' equipment are maintained; that the volume of traffic has increased since this matter was last considered a year ago; that the transportation in question is being performed on a profitable basis under the authorized rates; and that profitable operations for the coming year may reasonably be anticipated.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension is justified and should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 38032 of June 26, 1945, as amended, in the
