ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 125, at grade across the Stratford Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Stratford, Kings County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BAL-244.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Facific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be substantially as shown on plan attached to the application (Exhibit "A"). Grades of approach shall be not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
