ORDER OF REVOCATION

A certificate of public convenience and necessity was granted to Eugene Woods and C. E. Nordstrom by Decision No. 39076, dated January 27, 1947, in Application No. 28023 authorizing passenger stage service between Truckee and Cisco Grove and intermediate points. This certificate limited service during the period from December 15 of each year to April 1 of the following year.

Eugene Woods has informed the Commission by letter dated May 4, 1948 that that service was never established. Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 39076 in Application No. 28023 is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Woods and Nordstrom are hereby cancelled.
