O R D E R

Los Angeles County is authorized to relocate and reconstruct Slauson Avenue at grade across the tracks of Los Angeles Junction Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 25B-3.94-C. Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with agreement. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Los Angeles Junction Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on the plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 or 1A crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. 25B-3.91-C shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
