Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized
to reclassify its non-agency station of Clyde, County of Imperial
from Class "C" to Class "E", a station at which freight will not be
handled and to cancel all freight tariffs and schedules applying at
said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and
the public.

Within thirty days after the reclassification authorized
herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This au-
thorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless
time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty
days from the date hereof.
