O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Alameda Street at Firestone Park, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BG-489.4-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent.

Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B), and by flood lights. Said signals and floodlights may be operated from derails located on each side of the street but the signals shall be so controlled as to discontinue their warning aspect immediately after the last car has cleared the crossing even though the derails have not been restored to the derailing position.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
