OPINION AND ORDER

Malcom Word and Lynn E. Sigler have petitioned the Commission to modify Decision No. 41452 in this proceeding to include authorization to transfer a passenger stage operative right between Alturas and Fort Bidwell. By that decision the Commission authorized Malcom Word to sell and transfer to Lynn E. Sigler certain physical property and a highway common carrier operative right between Alturas and Fort Bidwell as described in Decision No. 38832, as amended by Decision No. 38895. Petitioners point out that it was their intent, as evidenced by Exhibit "A" attached to the original application, to request authority to transfer the passenger stage operative right between those points as well as the highway common carrier operative right.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraphs Nos. 1 and 2 of Decision No. 41452 in this proceeding are hereby amended to read as follows:

- "1. Malcom Word, after the effective date hereof and on or before June 30, 1948, may sell and transfer to Lynn E. Sigler, the passenger stage and highway common carrier operative rights and properties referred to in the contract of sale dated March 1, 1948, filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "A", and Lynn E. Sigler may acquire and thereafter operate the same, the sale and transfer to be made in accordance with the terms

and conditions of said contract, and Lynn E. Sigler, pursuant to the terms of said contract of sale, may incur indebtedness of \$2,400, payable as indicated therein.

- "2. Applicants shall comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79, 80 and 93-A, by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
