O R D E R

The City of Riverside is authorized to construct Crowell Avenue at grade across a track of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6W-4.44. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach substantially as shown on the plan attached to the application (Exhibit "C"). Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. 6W-4.38 about 308 feet easterly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,

or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
