FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission in its Decision No. 41680, issued May 28, 1948, authorized J. L. Brady, doing business as J. L. Brady Water Company, to sell and transfer to Maynard Smith that certain public utility water system used in supplying domestic service to customers in a subdivided tract known as Sunrise Homes, located near the City of Modesto, Stanislaus County.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said J. L. Brady be and he is hereby further authorized to transfer to Maynard Smith, on or before the first day of August, 1948, the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to said J. L. Brady in Decision No. 39663, dated November 26, 1946, to operate a public utility water system at Sunrise Homes, subject to the following provision:

That J. L. Brady shall file a written statement with this Commission, on or before the first day of August, 1948, setting forth the date said certificate of public convenience and necessity was actually transferred to said Maynard Smith.

The effective date of this Order is the date hereof.
