ORIGINALSUPPLEMENTAL OPINION ON PETITION FOR MODIFICATION

The applicant in this matter has filed a petition for modification of the Commission's Decision 40926, prescribing increased rates for water service rendered by applicant as a public utility near the city of Healdsburg, Sonoma County. The petitioner does not seek a rehearing, nor does it request that the Commission modify its rate order in any respect. It is alleged merely that certain statements contained in the opinion are not supported by the evidence presented at the hearing had upon the application. The Commission has carefully considered the petition and it is concluded that no good purpose would be served by modifying the original opinion in any particular respect. The burden of the petition is that statements contained in the Commission's opinion would indicate that many customers testified that they had been refused service except for essential household purposes. Perhaps the language used in the opinion does convey the impression that the Commission was making the finding that service had been denied, whereas the record indicates only that service had been discouraged for the use of water for the irrigation of gardens and lawns. The Commission readily concedes that an error was also made in reference to the charges that had heretofore been made for service to apartments, cabins and courts. However, inasmuch as the

applicant does not object to the rates which the Commission prescribed in this decision, and as the exceptions taken to statements in the opinion do not affect the order made in the proceeding, it is concluded that the petition should be denied.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition for modification of the opinion in Commission's Decision No. 40926 in the above-entitled matter be and it is hereby denied.
