O R D E R

The City of Richmond is authorized to widen 7th Street at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company in said city, at the location described in the application, and identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-17.6-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing, and grades of approach, shall be substantially as shown on plan accompanying application (Exhibit "A"). Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs, (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
