FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission in its Decision No. 41360, issued on March 23, 1948, granted Del Paso Water Co. a limited certificate of public convenience and necessity to serve approximately 305 acres in Sacramento County.

The decision provided that written acceptance of the limited certificate be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of the order, and further provided that issuance of a permanent certificate be made contingent upon acquisition by Del Paso Water Co. of full title and ownership of all of the facilities of the water system.

Written acceptance of the limited preliminary certificate having been filed, together with an affidavit to the effect that all essential water utility properties have been acquired by applicant, and applicant having requested the issuance of a permanent certificate limited in scope to the Del Paso Manor Tract, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity, issued by Decision No. 41360, is hereby made permanent.
