O R D E R

Tidewater Southern Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across certain streets in the City of Turlock, Stanislaus County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

- Crossing with a portion of Castor Street as Crossing No. 75-C-5.78-C
- Crossing with Lander Street as a portion of Crossing No. 75-C-5.8
- Crossing with "B" Street as Crossing No. 75-C-5.84-C.

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order

shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
