OPINION AND ORDER

Arvin Line has asked the Commission to place a restriction against local passenger traffic on the Mojave-Beecher's Corners segment of its recently authorized route over U. S. Highway 466 between Mojave and Barstow. (Decision No. 41511, Application No. 29100.) Following issuance of the Commission's ex parte order granting the extended right, Los Angeles Trona Stages, Inc., operating between Mojave and Beecher's Corners over the same route, requested Arvin Line to procure a modification of its certificate, which Arvin Line agreed to do. The two carriers have worked out a mutually satisfactory form of restriction.

The request appears to be a reasonable one. Under the circumstances it should be granted to take effect immediately. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the first ordering paragraph of Decision No. 41511 be and it is hereby amended by adding the following language to said paragraph immediately after the word "operations" appearing at the end thereof:

"The foregoing certificate is granted subject to the restriction that no passengers, baggage or express may be transported which have both origin and destination in the area lying between Mojave and Beecher's Corners.

"Service may be provided from points in the restricted area to points outside the restricted area or from points outside the restricted area to points inside the restricted area."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
