SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 41837 of July 13, 1948, in this proceeding, Main Street Corporation was authorized to discontinue public utility warehouse operations in Los Angeles. The authority is subject to the condition, among others, that operations shall not be discontinued until all of the property has been removed from storage. Amendment of the authority is now sought by excluding property of the Los Angeles Brewing Co. from these conditions.

The verified application shows that the warehouse property has been sold to Los Angeles Brewing Co. and that the buyer has temporarily leased a portion of the warehouse to applicant to enable continued operation of the warehouse until the stored property could be removed. Under the lease, certain property stored for the Los Angeles Brewing Co. shall remain in storage until the lease expires and possession of the leased portion of the warehouse is surrendered to the Brewing Company. Applicant desires amendment of the conditions of said Decision No. 41837 so that the property in question need not be removed from the warehouse prior to the discontinuance of its operations.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought amendment should be made.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Conditions 1, 2 and 6 of the ordering paragraph of Decision No. 41837 of July 13, 1948, in this proceeding, be and they are hereby amended by inserting the words "(other than property of Los Angeles Brewing Co.)" after the word "property" in the fourth line of Condition 1; by substituting "thirty (30) days" for "ten (10) days" in line one of Condition 2; and by inserting the words "(other than the property of Los Angeles Brewing Co.)" after the word "property" in line two of Condition 6.

In all other respects said Decision No. 41837 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
