In the Matter of the Application ORIGINAL CALIFORNIA WATER & TELEPHONE COMPANY, a corporation, to transfer and sell to MABEL W. JACKS, doing business under the name and style of MONTE REGIO WATER SYSTEM, a public utility property. Application No. 29579 ORDER California Water & Telephone Company, a corporation, asks the Commission for authority to sell and transfer a short section of water main together with a fire hydrant connected thereto, being a portion of its distribution system in said company's Monterey Peninsula Division, to Mabel W. Jacks, doing business as Monte Regio Water System operating a water property located partially within the city of Monterey and partially within the County of Monterey. The property to be transfered consists of 580 feet of four-inch cast iron main and a cast iron fire hydrant with connections located in and along Via Chiquita and Herman Drive within the city of Monterey. The consideration to be paid therefor is \$731.60. It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows: That California Water & Telephone Company, be and it is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to Mabel W. Jacks, doing business as Monte Regio Water System, on or before October 1, 1948, that certain section of cast iron water main together with connected fire hydrant located in and along Via Chiquita and Herman Drive in the city of Monterey as said property is more particularly described in the copy of the bill of sale marked Exhibit "A" attached to this application and made a part of this Order by reference: of this Order by reference:

2. That within sixty (60) days after the sale and transfer of the above properties, California Water & Telephone Company shall file with this Commission a statement showing the date upon which it relinquished control and possession of said property and a copy of each journal entry used to record on its books the sale thereof.

The effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
