OPINION AND ORDER

Richard H. Marshall, an individual doing business as Cone Ice and Cold Storage Company, owns and operates a public utility cold storage warehouse at Red Bluff. He seeks authority to transfer the assets of his business to Richard H. Marshall and C. R. Armstrong, a partnership.

The verified application shows that G. R. Armstrong is presently employed as manager of the business and that the proposed partnership will promote efficiency in the conduct of the operation. No change is proposed in the service available to the public or in the rates therefor.

The following statement shows the assets to be contributed to, and the liabilities to be assumed by Cone Ice and Cold Storage Company, a partnership.

Armstrong, a partnership, shall supplement or reissue tariffs on file with the Commission in so far as they name rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of Richard H. Marshall at Red Bluff, to show that Richard H. Marshall has withdrawn or cancelled said rates, rules and regulations and that Richard H. Marshall and G. R. Armstrong, a partnership, have concurrently adopted or established them as their own; and that tariff filings made pursuent to this order shall in all other respects comply with regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
