for an order of the Public Utilities
Commission authorizing applicant to
construct a railroad crossing.

O R D E R

The City of Visalia, Tulare County is authorized to construct Burke Street at grade across a main track and three side tracks of Southern Pacific Company in said city, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BAC-253.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
