SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By petition, Pacific Motor Trucking Company seeks authority to enlarge its pickup and delivery zones at Paradise and Optimo. The verified petition shows that the areas in question are contiguous to and actually parts of the respective communities; that shippers in these areas have requested pickup and delivery service; that the proposed extensions are within three miles of the post offices of the communities involved; and that there are no similarly situated industries or persons in the vicinity of Paradise and Optimo that are not now receiving similar service. Because of the relatively short distances involved, resulting deviations from the established minimum rates will be slight.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the granting of the sought authority is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioner be and it is hereby authorized to enlarge its pickup and delivery zones at Paradise and Optimo as requested; and to establish for the transportation involved, within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and on

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not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, rates less than the minimum rates prescribed by Decision No. 31606, as amended, in this proceeding, but not less than those prescribed for like transportation to and from Paradise and Optimo, respectively.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
