ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing that by Decision No. 40103 of March 25, 1947, in the above numbered application, Hood Trucking Co., a Corporation, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of property between San Francisco Bay points and points in Lake County and intermediate points, as more specifically detailed in said decision; it further appearing from investigations by the Commission's staff and a written statement of Harold O. Hood, president of said corporation, that all service has been discontinued; it further appearing that no suspension of any operations herein has at any time been authorized by the Commission; and it being found that the entire operations and services of said carrier, Hood Trucking Co., as authorized by said Decision No. 40103 have been discontinued without authority of the Commission, thereby resulting in abandonment of said operations and services;

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above mentioned operative right of Hood Trucking Co. granted by said Decision No. 40103 be and it is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and time tables on

file are hereby cancelled and annulled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service hereof in the manner provided by law unless said Hood Trucking Co., before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
